5. THE PARODIST, PINOT GRIGIO HUNGARY

8. DOMAINE PASSY LE CLOU, CHABLIS (VEGAN) FRANCE

The real thing! No wonder its popularity is so enduring. This is a great example: A lovely pale golden colour with floral notes and a hint of white fruits (apple, pear) and citrus on the nose ... and that classic taste – fresh and flinty with a lovely minerality.

RED WINES

11. TERRA VEGA, MERLOT RESERVA CHILE
